### Vaccination: The following vaccines are required for surgery.

Please be sure to Bring Proof of Vaccination

1. Distemper (DHPP) – \$36.70
2. Bordetella – \$24.80
3. Canine Influenza (H3N8) – \$26.97
4. Leptospirosis 4-way – \$24.80
5. Rabies – \$20.50

### Flea Prevention

For the safety of our guests we recommend the use of a monthly flea preventative. All pets checking into our facility will be checked for fleas. If fleas are present, we will treat your pet, and you will be responsible for charges.

### Optional Services We Recommend

A few optional services can be performed while your pet is here with us.

1. Preoperative liver and kidney blood testing (required for pets 6 years or older) – \$114.00
2. IV Catheter placed during surgery (required for pets under 5lbs) – \$72.75
3. Heartworm Disease Testing – \$58.35
4. Post-operative Pain Medication – \$57.65
5. Microchip – \$46.10

### Missing Vaccinations?

We can administer them while your pet is with us, for an additional charge.

#### Please note:

Should your pet weigh over 29 lbs, additional fees will apply for the use of anesthesia. If your pet exhibits any illness, including but not limited to: fleas, worms, ear mites, vomiting, diarrhea, bloody urine, respiratory problems, or severe skin problems, appropriate therapy and medication will be initiated. In addition, should your pet be in heat, pregnant, or have a cryptorchid, additional charges will apply.
